Customer Service Inspection Certificate

General Instructions:

The purpose of the form is to certify the identification and prevention of cross connections, potential contaminant hazards, and illegal lead materials as per *Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code(30 TAC) 290.46(j)(4)*. The form can be completed one of two ways:

- 1. The form can be printed and completed manually, or;
- 2. The form can be completed electronically through an electronic medium (tablet, laptop computer, etc.). The blue areas on the form can be completed electronically.

NOTE: The form is intended to be completed on-site while the inspection is occurring. If the form is completed electronically, the electronic device must also be onsite for proper use of this form.

The form must be printed and signed by the Inspector that performed the work. The hardcopy original or a copy must be provided to the City of Pearland for record keeping purposes as specified in 30 TAC 290.46(f)(3)(E)(iv).

Please follow these instructions when completing the form:

- Check boxes: If completing the form electronically, all check boxes are highlighted in blue and can be selected to make the desired indication. Selecting a box will insert an "X" in the box.
- 2. Remarks: The "Remarks" section of the form is expandable, which means your final report can be more than one page. Make sure to include all pages when submitting to the City of Pearland.

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Customer Service Inspection Certificate

Dear Pearland Water Customer:

The City of Pearland Water System is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") to obtain a completed Customer Service Inspection Certificate before providing continuous water service. Customer Service Certification requires an on-site inspection of your private water supply. The purpose of the inspection is to protect the potable water system from potential contamination. The inspection is not a plumbing inspection of the private water distribution system and does not negate the responsibility of a customer to install and maintain all plumbing in accordance with approved local, state and national plumbing codes.

Plumbing Inspectors licensed by the Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners, licensed plumbers holding the Water Supply Protection Specialist (WSPS) endorsement or Customer Service Inspector (CSI) licensed by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality and a certified water operator can conduct the inspection and complete the certificate form.

At the time of application for a Pearland potable water tap for the service address, the applicant signed a service agreement acknowledging the responsibility to conduct an on-site inspection. The original applicant may have been a developer, builder, plumber or homeowner. Regardless of who may have signed the original service agreement, the on-site inspection requirement is mandatory. Continuous water service is contingent upon the City of Pearland receipt of a completed Customer Service Inspection Certification.
