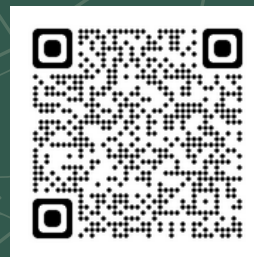

# WHAT IS A SWAP SHOP? HOW DOES IT WORK?

The DFNC Nature Novelties Swap Shop is a monthly program in which children and adults can bring in their nature finds to swap for other nature related items or DFNC merchandise.

Each item that is brought in is awarded points based on our point scale. We'll keep track of your points and you can save or spend as much as you please.

We encourage everyone to participate and look for items while they're exploring nature.

Please be sure to read through the items we do and do not accept very carefully before collecting any items.

Found something and you aren't sure what it is? Bring a photo of it in and our nature experts will help you to identify it and make sure it isn't on our unaccepted items list.

## ITEMS WE ACCEPT:

- Shells
- Skulls
- Antlers
- Fossils
- Acorns
- Leaves
- Wild Nuts
- Wild Seeds
- Pine Cones
- Snake Sheds
- Animal Teeth
- Petrified Wood
- Rocks & Minerals
- Nature Journals
- Observation Reports
- Clean Bones (not from birds)
- Casts of Animal Footprints
- Deceased Insects & Spiders



## ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Feces
- Roadkill
- Wild Flowers
- Bird Parts (feathers, eggs, nests, bones, skulls, etc.)
- Items from State Parks
- Items from National Parks
- Items from DFNC Grounds
- Native American Artifacts
- Intentionally Killed Items
- Dried Seahorses/Coral
- Live Plants & Animals

## WHY?

Some items, like bird parts, Native American Artifacts, and coral are protected and require special permitting for possession of the items.

Other items like wild flowers, live plants or live animals need to stay in the wild. Ecosystems have a delicate balance and all species have a purpose.
